Women at organizations that utilize, manufacture, sell, promote or manage technology in the Mid-Atlantic Region (Northern VA, Maryland and Washington, DC)

Awards deadline:

The final closing date for entries to the Mid-Atlantic Women & Technology Awards is **COB May 8, 2009.**

Entry form submissions:

Entries and supporting material must be submitted via email to [Rick Harris](#) by the deadline date. (May 8, 2009)

Multiple entries:

Multiple entries are permitted in any category and all entries will be judged separately.

Judging process:

Entries will be judged on the basis of the information provided to the judges on the entry form and any additional supporting materials. The most effective nominations will include a brief company and/or product description, a brief financial performance summary, highlights of the nominee's accomplishments where it relates to technology and why they should be considered a winner. Submissions that include financial data will be given stronger consideration.

Confidentiality:

Entries will be kept strictly confidential and seen only by the judging committee.

Finalists and winners:

The judging process is comprehensive and all finalists and winners will be recognized at the *The First Annual Women & Technology Awards* on Friday, June 12, 2009 from 12:00 NOON to 2:00 PM. We ask that all finalists be present at the ceremony and the winners will be announced at the lunch.
